#### **1. APPLICABLE SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1.1 The Sailing Instructions for this event, as required by RRS 90.2, are constituted by these Local Sailing Instructions in conjunction with the 2K Standard Sailing Instructions which can be found on the website of the 2K Team Racing International Association (<http://2kteamracing.com/>).
- 1.2 The bylaws of the Yacht Club Gaeta shall apply to all participants

#### **2. RACE OFFICE**

- 2.1 The race office is located at Yacht Club Gaeta
- 2.2 The race office will be open:
  - (a) For registration between 11:00 until 18:00 on the 6th June and from 08:30 until 09:00 on the 7th June 2019 unless extended by the OA
  - (b) Daily between 9:00 and 18:00
- 2.3 The official notice board is located at Race Office
- 2.4 Signals made ashore will be displayed from the official flagpole located near Yacht Club Caffè.

#### **3. BOATS AND SAILS**

- 3.1 The event will be sailed in Match 25 type boats.
- 3.2 Boats will be identified by sail numbers and hull numbers.
- 3.3 Boats will be equipped with the items as detailed in Addendum G

#### **4. CREW MEMBERS, NUMBER and SAFETY**

- 4.1 The total number of persons for one team, including the two skippers, shall be 8.
- 4.2 The maximum of any one gender shall be 50% of total, plus one.

#### **5. EVENT PROGRAMME, EVENT FORMAT AND STARTING SCHEDULES**

- 5.1 A list of eligible teams and the starting schedules are detailed in LSI Addendum E
- 5.2 The event programme and event format are detailed in LSI Addendum F.
- 5.3 The racing days are scheduled as on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2019 until 9<sup>th</sup> June 2019.
- 5.4 The intended time of the first warning signal each day is 10:00 am
- 5.5 The latest time for a warning signal on the last day of racing will be no later than 15:00.

## 6. RACING AREA and COURSE

- 6.1 The racing area will be inside Gaeta bay.
- 6.2 The courses as specified in the SSI will be used.
- 6.3 Description of Marks
- (a) The RC boat will be identified by a burgee of YCG.  
The RC boat will normally be the starting boat.
  - (b) The starting/finishing line mark will be red mark.
  - (c) Marks 1, 2 and 3 will be YELLOW.
